

History of Beat The Odds®

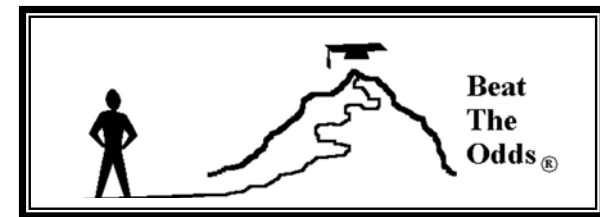
